<u>Literacy</u>

Our learning will be linked to the Creation Story, 'Handa's Surprise' and 'Where the Wild things are'. We will also be thinking about following instructions. **Phonics**

Phase 4 phonics and revising phase 2,3 and 4 tricky words for spelling and reading.

We will also begin to learn the phase 5 tricky words for reading.

<u>Writing</u>

We will continue to orally rehearse what we are going to write before writing it down, and will focus on writing sentences with the correct use of capital letters and full stops.

Understanding the World

We will hunt for mini beasts and make observations on their appearance and habitats.

We will compare Kenya with our local environment. We will taste and identify some fruits and vegetables. We will learn to programme the Beebots, and use the lpads to take photos of our favourite things in the natural world.

Expressive Arts and Design/Art and Design

We will experiment with how to join materials in different ways to help us create a junk model mini beast.

We will do some 'Feely' drawings and some 'Primal Paintings' to support the development of our art skills. Our music theme this half term is 'Big Bear Funk' and focuses on rhythm, beat and pace. <u>PSHE:</u> Healthy and Safer lifestyles: My Body and Growing Up

This will include a focus on healthy lifestyles including dental care and healthy eating. We will also be thinking about keeping ourselves safe both at home and in our worlds
