Literacy

Reading: Phase 1 phonics, which focuses on general sound discrimination, rhythm and rhyme, alliteration and voice sounds.

Phase 2 phonics will be introduced by half term. Watch out for the Phonic Fairy!!

We will also listen to and talk about stories we have read.

Writing: Mark making with a variety of different tools, establishing pencil grip and creating patterns.

Understanding the World

As the season changes, we will be investigating autumn by making observations in our outside area, making collections to explore and by celebrating harvest.

ICT-Using the technology we have in school including the Interactive Whiteboard, computers, Ipads, cameras and remote control cars.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be able to use the home corner and mud kitchen as well as have access to a variety of small world toys linking to everyday life; cars, trains and houses. We will use a variety of different media to create sunflowers and self-portraits and will explore those painted by Van Gogh to support us in this.

We will join in with simple songs and rhymes, learning to follow and then play a rhythm. Our theme is 'Me!'
