Covid Cases in school

Thank you to everyone for your support in helping to keep the children and staff safe this week by testing your children and if they show any symptoms, following this up with a PCR test. We are also aware that many, many families are regularly using lateral flow tests and that this is helping to identify asymptomatic cases quickly. Identifying positive cases is vital in helping us to stop the spread in school. Although we are still seeing some new cases, we hope that by working together we can all have a safe and happy Christmas holiday when it arrives.

Foundation/KS1 Nativity

We have very sadly made the difficult decision to cancel this year's nativity play. There are 3 main reasons for this; firstly over the last 10 days we have averaged around 50% absence across Monet and Van Gogh classes, making it incredibly difficult to teach songs and practise lines. In addition, we were advised to 'ring-fence' Monet class as numbers of cases were rising and this has meant that they have not been able to practise or learn alongside Van Gogh class at all. This has meant that we can't rehearse together. Lastly, staff absence due to Covid has put a great deal of pressure on staffing and our priority has been to ensure continuity of learning for all children, both at school and those accessing learning from home and this has left very little capacity to focus on the nativity.

Whilst we appreciate that this is disappointing, I am hopeful that parents will understand the difficulties that we have faced, and continue to face this half term. We do hope to do something later in the year if we are able.

Household Support Fund and the Christmas Holidays

This fund is aimed at supporting vulnerable households over the winter months in response to Covid-19 via a Direct Food Voucher Scheme.
