



Accelerated Reader Advantage (ARA) combines two key elements of baseline assessment and personalised reading practice to promote reading for pleasure and encourage pupils to read more books for pleasure.

ARA is formed of STAR Reading and Accelerated Reader (AR), which together inform instruction and engage pupils — helping them achieve their full literacy potential.

Inform

The STAR Reading component of Accelerated Reader Advantage (ARA) is computer-adaptive baseline assessment software that quickly and accurately establishes the actual reading level of individual pupils so that growth can be easily measured and tracked over time.



Up to 16 key reports are available that aid screening, placement, progress monitoring and growth measurement. The wealth of information available can be used to inform the creation of a personalised reading plan for every pupil.

Each completed assessment establishes a Zone of Proximal Development (ZPD) or reading range for use with Accelerated Reader, in addition to a National Curriculum level and sublevel.







Engage

The practice element of Accelerated Reader Advantage is Accelerated Reader, which utilises the STAR Reading results to offer fun, motivational quizzes based on the books deemed most suitable for pupils according to their individual ZPD.

The ZPD identifies a Book Level (an appropriate reading range) for each pupil containing books that are deemed neither too easy nor too challenging, so that they can enjoy the text and gain the necessary reading practice to improve.

Once completed, the pupil takes a fun, motivational Accelerated Reader (AR) quiz based on the text. Over 18,000 popular fiction and non-fiction titles have already been quizzed, with a further 200 added each month. In addition to these Comprehension quizzes, Vocabulary Practice and Literacy Skills quizzes are also available on a number of titles.



Both the pupil and teacher receive the results of the quiz the moment it has been completed in the form of a TOPS (The Opportunity to Praise Students) report, which details whether or not the recommended 85% pass level has been reached and highlights areas for improvement. In addition to providing valuable information for the teacher, it makes an excellent home-school report that keeps parents and guardians regularly informed of reading progress.



Pupils earn points each time they successfully pass a quiz, which count towards their individual and class targets set by the teacher using the information provided by STAR Reading.

This competitive element of the program really engages and motivates pupils of all ages to pick up another book as soon as they have successfully quizzed their last one.

Getting started with ARA:

Accelerated Reader Advantage is available by subscription and hosted online at Renaissance Place (RP). STAR Reading assessment and Accelerated Reader quizzes can be administered at any time, from any school computer, whilst Accelerated Reader quizzes can also be completed using Renaissance Learning's NEO 2 writing tool. For best results, we recommend between 20-30 minutes daily reading practice for every pupil.

AR BookFinder and AR BookGuide are useful websites that allow pupils, parents, teachers and librarians to quickly and easily search for books that have been AR quizzed.

Home Connect is a unique feature of RP that significantly aids home-school communication by allowing parents and guardians to access information about their child's progress with Accelerated Reader.

They can see which books have been read and quizzed and all the quiz results. Up to six family members can receive automatic email alerts every time a quiz is completed.



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
