School day times

Just a quick reminder that school starts at 8:50am, with the gates open from 8:30am (if dry) for you to join in the Daily Mile. If wet they will be open at 8:40am. Please do wait for a member of staff to open the gate in the morning so that we know when children are on site.

The front gate lock has now been checked and times amended. If the key pad is lit in red then the gate magnet is disabled so please push the gate open, but do not prop the gate open. If the key pad is lit blue, then please ring for entry as the gate is magnetised. We will no longer be hooking the gate open at the start and end of the day.

School lunches

Parents of children in Van Gogh and Monet class have chosen meals for their children for the remainder of term. However, we have several children who are arriving with packed lunches despite a school meal being ordered. If you change your mind and decide to send a packed lunch, please do email the office to let us know so that meals are not wasted.

It is difficult for a small school to carry debt, however please do talk to us if you have concerns about being able to clear debt or pay for meals.
