Covid Test and Trace

We would like to remind parents that we do have a responsibility with tracking and tracing contacts of confirmed positive cases until the 29th March. Therefore, it is vital that parents do let us know if their child develops symptoms at any time between the end of school today and the 29th March. Please inform us via the office@abbotsripton.cambs.sch.uk email address. We would also request that if your child does develop symptoms, you visit a test centre rather than requesting a postal test if possible as results are returned much more quickly. Please then inform us of the result of your child's test as soon as you can, again via the office email address.

If we are informed of a member of school staff or a pupil testing positive, we will follow Public Health advice regarding who to inform and will do this by telephone for anyone who needs to isolate because they have been in contact with the positive case whilst in school.
