English:

*Our first writing stimulus will came from the adventure film called 'One Smal Step' *We will be developing our skills for writing by firstly imitating a variety of sentence structures. *Our sentence structures will allow us to rehearse the skills of applying high quality word chaices combined with the appropriate grammatical structure. *We will cohesively stack our sentences. *Independently, we will be challenged to write our own narratives.


<u>Science:</u>

Properties and Changes of Materials

*We will compare and group together materials on the basis of their properties, including their hardness, solubility, transparency, conductivity and response to magnets. *We will investigate those materials that dissolve in liquid to form a solution and describe how to recover a substance from a solution.

*We will use our knowledge of solids, liquids and gases to decide how mixtures might be separated, including through filtering, sieving and evaparating.

*We will explore dissolving, mixing and changes of state that are reversible changes and those changes that result in the formation of new materials.

Geography:

What are the similarities and differences between the Rivers Severn and the River Indus? We will carry out an in-depth study of both of these rivers as well as learning about how rivers are formed

Maths:

Place Value (Year 5 and 6 Objectives): *Understand the place value of numbers up to ten million (Year 6) and ane million (Year 5). *Compare and acter any number. *Round numbers to varying degrees of accuracy. *Calculate with negative numbers. Number (Year 6 Objectives): *Use formal written methods to calculate a range of problems using all four number operations. *Concolidate understanding of cube, square and prime numbers. *Calculate using factors, multiples and the order of operations. Number (Year 5 Objectives): *Add and subtract using farmal written methods. *Develop an awareness of inverse operations.

Camputing: We will learn how the internet works by sending packets of data as well as how use a search engine and understand how search results are ranked and influenced.
