Literacy:

Reading:

Phase 2 phonics We will learn each weekly set of sounds and complete the phase at the end of the half term. We will learn to segment words for reading and to blend them back into words again. We will also listen to and talk about stories we have read.

Writing:

We will mark make with a variety of different tools, establishing pencil grip and creating patterns.

We will learn the correct formation of letters and begin to apply the sounds we have learnt to our writing.

Understanding the World

We will explore different materials, those that are reflective and those that are not.

There will be lots of opportunities to discuss patterns and changes in our world.
