Parent Consultations

Thank you to everyone who has replied to the email sent out this week about booking a Parent Consultation appointment. These will be collated and your time will be emailed out to you on the Monday after half term.

Menu and dinner money for next half term.

Please find attached a slightly altered menu for after half term. There are 7 weeks next half term so the cost of dinners will be \pounds 84.00 (35 days @ \pounds 2.40) if your child has a hot meal every day (Kandinsky and Picasso classes only). Please ensure that payment is received promptly. If you are concerned about your child bringing cash into school with them, please hand to the adult out on duty on the field at the start or end of the day. We continue to look into direct payments but currently this is not available.



If your child has a packed lunch, please can we remind parents that we are a nut free school. Therefore, it is important that parents do not send nut products in to school in packed lunches.

Admissions to Secondary School – Deadline for applications 31st October

Morning start time

After half term we would like to slightly adjust our start time in the morning. Please could we ask that all children arrive between **8:40am and 8:55am**. We have become increasingly aware of the impact of children arriving at the gate at 9am and not being ready to learn until well after this due to washing hands, putting their things away etc. By arriving promptly before 8:55am we hope that teaching can start for all children at 9am. Your support with this is greatly appreciated.



After school clubs

We have worked hard to be in a position to be able to offer some after school clubs next half term. We know that many children have missed them! With this newsletter is a clubs booking form and as you can see we are offering one club each to Monet, Kandinsky and Picasso (we only ever offer clubs for Reception children later in the year when they are more settled). By offering the clubs to separate classes, we are still able to keep the children in their separate groups. The club providers have shared their Covid Risk Assessments with us and we have shared the relevant parts of our school one with them. The collection arrangements for clubs are slightly different so if your child signs up, we would ask you to wait at the front of school in your car. As each car pulls up to the layby, children will be dismissed to cars. As the car in front of you moves away, move up until you are at the layby.

Hand sanitiser



We are aware that some children are bringing hand sanitiser into school and whilst we think this is instilling good habits in children, we would ask that these sanitisers are kept at home. By using school hand sanitiser we can guarantee the recommended minimum alcohol content and if we have any issues for example with children having a reaction, we know exactly what has been used. This isn't possible if children are using and

sharing sanitiser brought in to school from home. Hand sanitiser is freely available in school and children also have access to regular hand washing through the day too. Many thanks.


Cupcake Raffle
