### First Aid Policy

We have reviewed our First Aid policy in school and it has now been agreed by the Governors. The main change is that first aid slips will not be sent home with your child for every injury. If the first aider deems the injury to be significant then you will receive a slip or telephone contact as normal.

• An accident form will be completed by the first aider on the same day or as soon as possible after an incident resulting in an injury, dependent on the seriousness of the incident.

### **Perimeter fencing**

We have been working extremely hard to secure additional funding from the Diocese to erect a secure perimeter fence around our school site. We are delighted that we were successful; receiving funding of almost £28,000!! As a result, this fencing project will begin on Monday!

The fence will be on the inside of the current wooden fencing and will include new gates onto the site. These gates will be on a magnetic timer so will lock and unlock automatically between certain times. This will mean that our site is more secure both when the children are on site and also whilst children are not on site (i.e. at weekends and in school holidays).

Once the gates are installed, we will inform parents about the timings and how to access the site outside of the 'unlock' times. The pedestrian gate at the front of the school will also be locked on a timer and there will only be 1 entry point from the carpark and not 2 which we currently have.

Please do take care on our site whilst this work is happening next week and please do not allow your children to play onsite after school. Could I also politely request that you leave the site with your children **promptly** whilst this work is happening as the contractor is hoping to work as many daylight hours as possible to finish within a week!


# Rotary Club Primary Schools Year 6 Quiz
