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Year 6 progress from the end of Year 2

Most schools will have progress scores between -5 and +5. If a school has a progress score of 0.0 it means that on average their pupils achieved similar results at the end of end of KS2 (end of Year 6) to other pupils nationally with similar results at the end of KS1 (end of Year 2). If a school has a positive progress score, this means that on average, their pupils made more progress than pupils in other schools with similar results in KS1.
