

The children have enjoyed coming into school today in their non- uniform following members of Picasso class counting the tokens to check the winner.



Diwali celebration



On Thursday 4th November we will be holding a Diwali Day in school to learn about this important festival which is one of the major festivals celebrated by Hindus, Sikhs and some Buddhists.

The children will learn about the story of Rama and Sita as well as some of the ways that the festival is celebrated by Hindus and Sikhs. Some children will create brightly coloured rangoli patterns and others will make lanterns as Diwali is often known as the festival of lights. Our older children will consider the similarities with festivals that they know from other faiths as well as the importance of 'light' for other faiths.

In order to make our Diwali day a true celebration, we would like children to come to school dressed in a brightly coloured top – ideally a plain but brightly coloured t-shirt or jumper would be great.
