

<p><i>Literacy/ Reading</i></p> <p>Read a book with your child and talk about the characters, setting and events in the book. Why did they enjoy it? Would they read it again?</p>	<p><i>Expressive Art and Design -</i></p> <p>Create a 'chatter box'. Find a box and put inside different things. These could be linked to a story, or just things that interest your child. Encourage them to talk about why they have put them in the box . Can they make up stories with them, or explain what they are?</p>	<p><i>Maths: Shape, space and measure;</i></p> <p>Empty a cupboard in your kitchen full of groceries. Can your child pick them up and put them in order of weight/ size or height?</p>
