## Topic:

Our topic focus continues to be history this term. We will be completing our breadth study of British Monarchs.

This half term we are moving on to explore Queen Elizabeth I and her reign. In this, we will spend time investigating, discussing and debating events during the Spanish Armada.

## Science:

Our Science topic this half term is 'Properties and Changes of Materials'.

We will conduct experiments, hypothesise ideas and record results. We will consider how to maintain a fair test, whilst exploring a range of concepts, including reversible and irreversible changes.



## Maths:

Year 5: \*Solve problems involving fractions.

\*Recognise the per cent symbol (%) and understand that per cent relates to 'number of parts per hundred', and write percentages as a fraction with denominator 100, and as a decimal.

\*Calculate perimeter/area—rectilinear shapes.

Year 6: \*Solve problems involving fractions.

\*Add and subtract fractions with different denominators and mixed numbers, using the concept of equivalent fractions

\*Solve problems involving the calculation of percentages (for example, of measures, and such as 15% of 360)/ the use of percentages for comparison.

\*Calculate area and perimeter—rectangles, squares, triangles, parallelograms.

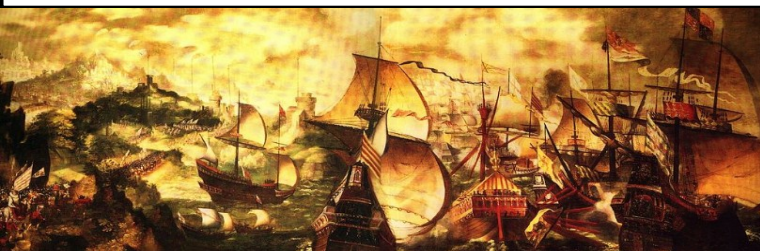
## Art/DT:
