# **Diary Dates**

#### **Daisies Montessori Nursery update**

As you will see, the building has sprung up over the summer and work is on schedule to be completed on time. We are aware some of the school site is looking a little 'worn' but this will be rectified on completion. It is unlikely that any nursery children will start on our site until Christmas but we will let you know when we have a date.

# **Home Learning**

Next week we will be seeking your views on our Home Learning before we make a final decision on the format that this will take for the coming year. In the past we have set 'project' type learning, as well as online learning and also weekly tasks. We haven't made a decision for this year as we felt that it was important to ask you for your views. # Clubs

Clubs start again next week for Monet, Kandinsky and Picasso. They will be run by Mr Clarke and his team. This term we are offering a Multi-Skills club where the children will be able to try a selection of different sports and sports skills. We will continue to subsidise these clubs from our Sports Premium funding which enables us to offer them at £1.50 a week per child. Please see the attached booking form for the day your child's class has been allocated. Places are booked on a first come first served basis so please ensure your booking form is returned promptly. Children will not be able to stay if we have not received the form and payment.

# New menu and dinner money

We have sent home a new menu today, which will run until October half term. The cost of a school meal each day has stayed the same as last year at £2.40. We feel that the hot meal provided by Jo is great value as she continues to cook on site with fresh ingredients each day. The Government are still acknowledging the huge benefits of having a hot meal at school and are



therefore still funding the free school meals for KS1. If your child is in Van Gogh or Monet class there is therefore no charge for their meal.

If your child is having a school meal and they are in KS2 (Kandinsky or Picasso Class) the cost of meals this half term will be £88.80 (37 days @ £2.40). If you wish to pay weekly the cost is £12.00. Your child does not need to have a hot meal every day and can have a mix of packed and school lunches – just let us know which days they plan to stay. Similarly, if your child usually has a packed lunch but they would like an adhoc meal, simply send them with the £2.40 on the day and a meal can be ordered by them in the morning.

Please forward payment, via your child or hand to the adult on duty at the gate, in a sealed and named envelope. Cheques made payable to Abbots Ripton CE Primary School. A polite reminder that meals must be paid for in advance as we do not have the cash flow to manage debts in school.

#### No Nuts Please



Just a reminder for the new term that we are a **nut free school**. Please do not send your child into school with any nut based products in their packed lunch. Thank you for your support.

#### Break time snacks

All children in Reception and KS1 are offered a free piece of fruit or vegetable every day, however, any child in KS2 may bring a fresh fruit or vegetable snack to eat at play time. No other snacks are allowed.
