
Contacting members of staff

School Day

The school day runs from 8:50am – 3:15pm. Please ensure that your child has arrived on the school playground before 8:50am so that they can line up with their class and start the day correctly; it can be very unsettling for children when they arrive after their peers.



Monies sent into school

Dinner money

Water

Can we remind you that each child should bring in a water bottle for their use throughout the day. This should **only** contain water and not fruit juice or squash. These bottles can be refilled during the day and will come home at the end of school for you to wash.
