


English:

Topic:

Our topic focus is history this term. We will be looking at Pre-history: The Stone Age to The Iron Age.

We will use historical sources to learn about life in The Stone Age, The Bronze Age and The Iron Age. We will compare how each of these sets of people lived including looking at the features of their homes, their food and their jobs.

Science:

Our topic is Rocks.

We will look at a variety of rock samples and explore the properties of rocks, how fossils are formed and volcanoes. We will practise sorting and classifying as well as describing.

We will also do some experiments with soil samples and investigate erosion and how this affects the land.

Maths:

Year 3:

To read, write, order and partition numbers to 100.

To explore shapes and use mathematical language to sort and classify them.

Year 4:

To read, write, order and partition numbers to 1000.

To count backwards through zero to negative numbers.

To add and subtract mentally.

To use column method for addition and subtraction up to 9999.

To apply their mathematical knowledge to a variety of problems which will extend their reasoning and enquiry skills.
