Test and Trace

Covid Test and Trace

We would like to remind parents that we do have a responsibility with tracking and tracing contacts of confirmed positive cases until the 31st May. Therefore, it is vital that parents do let us know if their child develops symptoms at any time between the end of school today and the 31st May. Please inform us via the office@abbotsripton.cambs.sch.uk email address. We would also request that if your child does develop symptoms, you visit a test centre rather than requesting a postal test if possible as results are returned much more quickly. Please then inform us of the result of your child's test as soon as you can, again via the office email address.

If we are informed of a member of school staff or a pupil testing positive, we will follow Public Health advice regarding who to inform and will do this by telephone for anyone who needs to isolate because they have been in contact with the positive case whilst in school.

After school clubs

We have sent home booking forms for the next half term for the clubs on offer. If you wish your child to join a club, then please complete and return the form with payment by Tuesday 7th June.

Rise and Shine Club

A reminder that our before school club every day starts at 8am and is an opportunity for children to be physically active before the school day. Please do let the office know if you would like your child to join – this can be ad hoc days or a longer term booking.

Relationships Education

With our newsletter on the 23rd April, we sent a letter about the new Relationships Education Curriculum, which becomes a statutory subject from September. Part of this letter asked if parents would be interested in joining a consultation group.
