English: Continue with Last stop on Market Street - Narrative. Use adjectives to describe sights, sounds and touch using adjectives. Use precise nouns, action verbs and time adverbials. Use simile, alliteration and repetition for effect. Explore inner thoughts, feelings and speech to add detail for the reader. Word work to include changes to words - contractions in speech and adding prefixes to root words to change the meaning. How to make an animal treat -**Instructions.** We will be examining the structural features of instructions – heading, call to action, equipment, ordered steps and rhetorical questions. Language features to include the use of imperative verbs, temporal conjunctions, superlatives, alliteration and complex sentences using 'if.' Punctuation will focus on question marks and brackets.

Please continue to support with learning tricky words for reading and spelling.

History – The Queens Platinum Jubilee. What is a monarch? Who is our monarch today in 2022? Why did Princess Elizabeth become Queen Elizabeth II? What is a coronation? Who are the Queen's relatives? PSHE - My Emotions. Understand and manage a range of feelings. Understand impulsive and thought through behaviour. Know how to get support. Calming and relaxing. Being assertive.

Music – Rhythm in the way we walk. A focus on pulse, rhythm and pitch, through reggae, rapping, dancing and singing.

Art: Wax resist old coins. The children will make printing templates. Focus on stamps and coins. Jubilee coronets.
