Please choose one activity a week to enjoy with your child.
Please just initial the task completed. There is no obligation for home learning to be recorded in any way.

Speaking and Listening
Give your child simple instructions and see how many things they can remember! It could range from only one thing, e.g. "Find a plate", to lots of things, like "Find a plate, a spoon, a cup and a fork." Can they give you instructions?

PSED - Play a board game with your child. Can they take turns and share fairly? Do they recognise the number patterns on the dice? Can they count on spaces on the board?



Understanding the world- How many different coloured leaves can you find? Talk about the colours and how the seasons are changing.

Speaking and Listening- Have a 'listening minute', where you spend a whole minute just listening to the world around you, then talk about all the sounds you hear afterwards. Were the sounds loud or quiet? Nearby or far away? High or low?
