#### **Covid Vaccination Programme**

Covid Vaccinations are available for anyone over the age of 5, please see the attached poster for details. Your nearest venue might be a local pharmacy or outreach venue so please do check on the links provided to find the most convenient location for your family.

#### Free School Meal Entitlement

All children who are eligible for Free School meals are also eligible for free holiday activity clubs in the summer holiday. We would strongly encourage any parent who thinks they might be eligible to follow the link to complete a brief online application at <a href="https://www.cambridgeshire.gov.uk/freeschoolmeals">www.cambridgeshire.gov.uk/freeschoolmeals</a> from where you will receive an instant response as to your eligibility status.



The criteria includes anyone claiming the following:

- Income Support.
- Income Based Job Seekers Allowance.
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance.
- Child Tax Credit but no element of Working Tax Credit and have an annual income (as assessed by HM Revenue and Customs (HMRC)) that does not exceed £16,190.
- If you are supported under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit.
- Working Tax Credit during the four week period immediately after your employment finishes or after you start to work less hours per week.
- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400 (as from 1 April 2018).
